BILL NO. HB 056

Analysis

HB 056 adds arson in the first and second degrees to those crimes defined as a “serious felony offense” in the statute defining conspiracy. With this amendment, the crime of conspiracy would prohibit persons from conspiring to commit arson in the first or second degree.

Passage of this legislation would have no foreseeable fiscal impact on the Department of Law.
