### Analysis

HB 155 proposes to change the threshold for coverage under Alaska's Little Davis Bacon Act ("LDBA") (AS 36.05.010 – AS 36.05.110) from \$2,000 to \$75,000 and to exempt regional and municipal school district public construction contracts from Little Davis Bacon Act requirements. In FY2010, the Division of Labor Standards and Safety had a total of 2,245 public construction projects filed. Of those, a total of 1,413 public construction projects had contract values less than \$75,000 with a filing fee revenue of \$152.8. In FY2010, 205 public construction projects were awarded by regional or municipal school districts with a filing fee revenue of \$243.8. For a total of \$396.6 in reduced revenue to the state.

HB 155 as currently worded eliminates LDBA coverage for public construction projects awarded by a village or other unorganized communities that are not state subdivisions. The amount of filing fee revenue associated with projects awarded by villages and other unorganized communities is not available at this time.
