HB125 moves the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to the Department of Commerce, Community and Economic Development (DCCED) from the Department of Public Safety (DPS). This fiscal note requests inter-agency receipt
authority within the Division of Administrative Services to receive funds from the ABC Board in line with the DCCED cost allocation for administrative support. On-going support covered under the cost allocation plan includes costs for
information technology, budget, procurement and human resource assistance. Among other items, the allocation will
