# FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- "An Act relating to prohibiting the use of cellular telephones when driving a motorvehicle."

# 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* **Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 28.35.165. Prohibited use of cellular telephone. (a) A person may not use a cellular telephone when driving a motor vehicle on a highway or vehicular way or area.
- 8 (b) This section does not apply to a person using a cellular telephone
- 9 (1) for emergency purposes, including an emergency call to a law 10 enforcement agency, fire department, or other emergency services agency or entity; or
- 11 (2) by hands-free mode.
- 12 (c) Notwithstanding another provision of law, a peace officer may not stop or 13 detain a motor vehicle to determine compliance with (a) of this section, or issue a 14 citation for a violation of (a) of this section, unless the peace officer has probable

1	cause to stop or detain the motor vehicle other than for a violation of (a) of this
2	section.
3	(d) In this section,
4	(1) "emergency" has the meaning given in AS 42.20.150;
5	(2) "hands-free mode" means use of a cellular telephone for listening
6	or talking by means of a speaker function, headset, or earpiece without holding the
7	telephone.
8	(e) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction and may be
9	punished as provided under AS 28.90.010.
