A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to penalties for certain alcohol offenses involving persons under 21**
2 **years of age committed by a sex offender or child kidnapper."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 04.16 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 04.16.059. Aggravated penalties for violations of AS 04.16.051 -**
6 **04.16.057 involving a person under 21 years of age and committed by a sex**
7 **offender or child kidnapper.** Notwithstanding AS 04.16.051 - 04.16.057 and
8 04.16.180, the penalty for a violation of AS 04.16.051 - 04.16.057 that involved a
9 person under 21 years of age and that was committed by a sex offender or child
10 kidnapper is as follows:

11 (1) if the underlying offense is a violation, a sex offender or child
12 kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class B misdemeanor and shall be
13 punished as provided in AS 12.55;

14 (2) if the underlying offense is a class A misdemeanor, a sex offender

1 or child kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class C felony and shall be
2 punished as provided in AS 12.55;

3 (3) if the underlying offense is a class C felony, a sex offender or child
4 kidnapper committing the offense is guilty of a class B felony and shall be punished as
5 provided in AS 12.55.

6 * **Sec. 2.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to
7 read:

8 **APPLICABILITY.** This Act applies to offenses committed on or after the effective
9 date of this Act.
