HB 174 requires state and municipal agencies, including the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), to extend the period of time for which certain authorizations are effective if the authorization has been stayed by a court or administrative order. Specifically, this bill applies to authorizations issued for mining activities under AS 27,
projects authorized by the Oil & Gas Conservation Commission under AS 31, and transportation projects listed in the state transportation plan by the Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities under AS 44.
DNR already routinely extends authorizations that have been stayed by a court or administrative order, therefore, the proposed legislation will not require the department to undertake any additional efforts that would require additional staff or resources.
