BILL NO. SB 13

## **Analysis**

The current statute (AS 41.21.026(d)) provides an exemption to disabled veterans from paying fees for overnight camping in a state park facility. SB 13 would expand the exemption from state park fees for disabled veterans to include the following additional park fees:

- Rental of public use cabins
- Use of an RV dump station
- Admission or guided tours to a visitor centor or historic site
- Use of an approved boat ramp
- Day use
- Attendance to educational programs

It would cost approximately \$10,000 in programming changes to the online cabin reservation system to implement the exemption from fees for disabled vets.

This legislation would result in a annual loss of revenue to the state of up to \$252,000 in park user fees. This fiscal note includes \$252,000 in general funds to replace the anticipated loss of revenue, to allow the same level of service in state parks to continue . If the lost fees are not replaced, the Division of Parks could lose approximately three park ranger positions.

It is likely some public use cabins could be vacant but not available to the public because they would be reserved by disabled vets but not used. There may be an increase in use and demand of park facilities as a result of this legislation.
