FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing November 18 of each year as Ted Stevens Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.067. Ted Stevens Day.** Ted Stevens day is established on
5 November 18 of each year to honor Theodore F. "Ted" Stevens, whose long record of
6 public service includes 40 years as a United States senator from Alaska, for his service
7 to the state and the nation. Ted Stevens Day may be observed by suitable observances
8 and exercises by civic groups and the public.
