Analysis

House Bill 190 changes the allowable absence rules for certain members of the armed forces for the purpose of determining eligiblity for permanent fund dividends. It exempts those who received three dividends prior to entering the armed forces from the rule that would disqualify them automatically after absence from Alaska of 10 years. It is estimated that 100 hours of programmer time will be necessary to make these changes.								
The Information & Instruction books must be changed in order to reflect changes to eligibility rules. The cost of printing and distributing new Information & Instruction books to the more than 280 distribution sites around Alaska is a direct increased cost to the division.
