FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to the Village Safe Water Act."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 46.07.080(2) is amended to read:

(2) "village" means <u>a village listed in 43 U.S.C. 1610 or 1615</u> [AN UNINCORPORATED COMMUNITY] that has between 25 and <u>1,000 residents</u> [600 PEOPLE RESIDING WITHIN A TWO-MILE RADIUS], a second class city, or a first class city <u>or home rule municipality</u> with not more than <u>1,000</u> [600] residents.

* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

TRANSITION. Notwithstanding the amendment to AS 46.07.080(2) by sec. 1 of this Act, a village for which Village Safe Water Act project funding was appropriated in a capital budget bill approved by the legislature for a fiscal year before fiscal year 2012 shall remain eligible to receive that Village Safe Water Act project funding after the effective date of this Act regardless of whether the village meets the definition of "village" in AS 46.07.080(2), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act.
