## FISCAL NOTE #2

## STATE OF ALASKA 2011 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. CSSB 15(HSS)

## **Analysis**

SB 15 raises one level the severity of offenses for providing alcohol to persons under 21 years of age if the offender is a sex offender or child kidnapper. For example, a nonlicensee who furnishes alcohol to a person under 21 years of age commits a class A misdemeanor for a first offense. SB 15 would make this offense a class C felony if the offender was a sex offender or child kidnapper.								
This would have an indeterminate fiscal impact on the Department of Law. Any time an offense is raised from a misdemeanor to a felony there is an impact. Felony prosecutions require more time – for example, a felony requires a grand jury indictment and a jury of 12 persons.
