STATE OF ALASKA 2011 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB24

Analysis

This bill will create a nine member Sport Fishing Guide Services Board in the Department of Commerce, Community, and Economic Development (DCCED), and establish two new licensing categories.

As DCCED will have the authority to collect license fees, this will result in a loss of Fish & Game Fund revenue to ADF&G of approximately \$240.0 per year.

The cost of operating the exisiting program in ADF&G is approximately \$400.0, and includes statewide licensing of sport fishing business owners and sport fishing guides, registering all vessels used in guided sport fishing trips, and logbook reporting activities for all guided fishing trips. Annual revenue shortfalls of approximately \$200.0 have been covered by Fish & Game Funds. Adding two new license categories will increase program costs (logbooks, data processing, and recording) by an estimated \$40.0.

The department assumes fees will be set to generate enough revenue to the General Fund to fund the cost of administering the entire program, and that \$440.0 interagency receipts will be received by ADF&G from DCCED via a Reimbursable Services Agreement.
