A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Alaska relating to deposits
- 2 to the constitutional budget reserve fund from surplus oil revenue.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * Section 1. Article IX, sec. 17(a), Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended to read:
- (a) There is established as a separate fund in the State treasury the budget reserve fund. Except for money deposited into the permanent fund under Section 15 of this article, the following shall be deposited in the budget reserve fund: all money received by the State after July 1, 1990, as a result of the termination, through settlement or otherwise, of an administrative proceeding or of litigation in a State or federal court involving mineral lease bonuses, rentals, royalties, royalty sale proceeds, federal mineral revenue sharing payments or bonuses, or involving taxes imposed on mineral income, production, or property, and two-thirds of the difference between \$6,000,000,000 adjusted by the cumulative change, derived from federal indices as prescribed by law, in population and inflation since July 1, 2013, and the actual annual unrestricted oil revenue as determined each year on July 1 for the previous fiscal year [SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE BUDGET RESERVE

1	FUND]. Money in the budget reserve fund shall be invested so as to yield competitive
2	market rates to the fund. Income of the fund shall be retained in the fund. Section 7 of
3	this article does not apply to deposits made to the fund under this subsection. Money
4	may be appropriated from the fund only as authorized under (b) or (c) of this section.
5	In this subsection, "unrestricted oil revenue" means oil lease bonuses, rentals,
6	royalties, royalty sale proceeds, federal oil revenue sharing payments or bonuses,
7	or taxes imposed on oil income, production, or property.
8	* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed before the voters of the
9	state at the next general election in conformity with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State
