#### A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act prohibiting the driver of a motor vehicle from reading or typing a text message

2 or other nonvoice message or communication on a cellular telephone, computer, or

3 personal data assistant while driving a motor vehicle."

### **4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 \* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
6 to read:

7 STATEMENT OF PURPOSE. The purpose of this Act is expressly to provide that the 8 use of a cellular telephone, computer, personal data assistant, or any other similar means for 9 texting or communicating in a manner proscribed by AS 28.35.161 is prohibited. It is the 10 opinion of the legislature that the use of these devices in a manner proscribed by 11 AS 28.35.161 is currently illegal in the state.

(a) A person commits the crime of driving <u>while texting, while</u>
 <u>communicating on a computer, or while</u> [WITH] a screen device <u>is</u> operating if [(1)]
