1 Designating February 2012 as American Heart Month.

2 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- 3 **WHEREAS** cardiovascular disease is the nation's leading cause of death; and
- 4 **WHEREAS** cardiovascular disease is the costliest disease in the nation, with direct
- 5 and indirect costs estimated to be \$297,700,000,000 a year; and
- 6 **WHEREAS** cardiovascular disease accounts for one out of three deaths nationwide;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS nearly 2,200 Americans die of cardiovascular disease each day, an
- 9 average of one death every 39 seconds; and
- 10 WHEREAS nearly 33 percent of deaths caused by cardiovascular disease occur in
- persons under 75 years of age; and
- 12 **WHEREAS**, this year, an estimated 785,000 people nationwide will have a new
- 13 coronary attack, an estimated 470,000 people nationwide will have a recurrent attack, and an
- additional 195,000 people nationwide will have a silent heart attack; and
- 15 WHEREAS the research is clear that there are preventive strategies, as well as
- 16 community-based strategies, that can increase survival rates from cardiovascular disease; and
