3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 44.12.074. Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders Awareness Day. Fetal
 Alcohol Spectrum Disorders Awareness Day is established on September 9 of each
 year to promote awareness of the fact that there is no known safe level of alcohol
 consumption during pregnancy, to promote awareness of the effects of prenatal
 exposure to alcohol, to increase identification of children with fetal alcohol spectrum
 disorders, and to improve the lives of those affected by fetal alcohol spectrum
 disorders.
