A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- 1 "An Act relating to prohibiting the use of cellular telephones by minors when driving
- 2 motor vehicles; and providing for an effective date."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:
- Sec. 28.35.165. Prohibited use of cellular telephone. (a) A person under 18 years of age may not use a cellular telephone when driving a motor vehicle on a highway or vehicular way or area.
 - (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a peace officer may not stop or detain a motor vehicle to determine compliance with (a) of this section, or issue a citation for a violation of (a) of this section, unless the peace officer is authorized by law to stop or detain the motor vehicle other than for a violation of (a) of this section.
- 12 (c) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction and may be 13 punished as provided under AS 28.90.010.
- * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 2011.
