#### A BILL

## FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act requiring the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to require
 airports to post warning signs outside of security screening areas warning passengers
 that they are subject to searches of their bodies by physical touching and by electronic
 devices that emit radiation."

#### 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

6 \* Section 1. AS 02.15.050 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(h) The department shall require each airport where screening of passengers
and property is actively being conducted as authorized by 49 U.S.C. 44901 to post a
warning sign that measures at least 11 inches by 14 inches within 30 feet of the
entrance to the passenger screening area. The sign must read as follows:
PASSENGER WARNING

Each passenger entering this security screening area is subject to a physical search of the passenger's body by another person who may touch the passenger in a way that some passengers may find offensive

and is also subject to a search by an electronic device that emits
 radiation used to produce an electronic image of the passenger that
 exposes or reveals physical characteristics of a person that are normally
 hidden by clothing and not normally visible to the public view.
