STATE OF ALASKA 2012 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. HB 359

Analysis

This bill adds human trafficking in the first degree and sex trafficking in the first degree to the conspiracy statues (AS 11.31.120). A person convicted of this new crime would be subject to punishment for a Class B felony. The average sentence for a Class B felony is five years. The average daily cost of care in a DOC facility is \$134.90. Therefore, one individual convicted of conspiring to commit sex trafficking in the first degree could cost the Department of Corrections \$246,192.50 based on a five year *average* sentence.

In the past five years, DOC has seen an average of 2.4 convictions for promoting prostitution (sex trafficking). However, DOC does not have any historical data on conspiracy to commit sex or human trafficking, as this would be a new crime if this legislation were to pass. Therefore, DOC is currently unable to quanitfy the fiscal impacts of the passage of this legislation.

The Department will closely monitor the potential future fiscal impacts should this legislation pass.
