Senate Bill 181 Closing Certain Land To Mineral Entry Sectional Analysis

- Section 1: States the purpose of Senate Bill 181. This Act approves the interim classification contained in Commissioner of Natural Resources' Mineral Order 1121 and in Amendment 3 to Mineral Closing Order 593, closing state land in the Glacier and Winner Creek drainages in the Girdwood area to new mineral entry. Closing these state-owned lands to mineral claims will enable continued recreational developments in accordance with area land use plans.
- **Section 2**: Identifies the land in the Glacier Creek and Winner Creek drainages that is closed to new mineral entry.
- Section 3: Amends the description of land in the Glacier Creek and Winner Creek drainages that were closed to mineral entry and approved by the legislature in sec. 2, ch. 8, SLA 2003 by excluding two additional federal mining claims lying east of Crow Creek Road that should have been listed in the original mineral closure order.
- **Section 4**: Provides for an immediate effective date.
