A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the length of a school week; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA: 2

3	* Section 1. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section
4	to read:
5	SCHOOL WEEK; PILOT PROJECT. (a) Notwithstanding the requirements of
6	AS 14.03.030 and 14.03.040, the board shall approve, at the request of the governing body of
7	a school district, a school week consisting of four days for a period not to exceed three school
8	years if the school district, within 30 days after the effective date of this Act,
9	(1) provides proof satisfactory to the board that students enrolled in the district
10	will receive the educational equivalent of a five-day school week;
11	(2) has involved affected students, teachers, and the community in requesting
12	a four-day school week;
13	(3) submits public comment to the board that demonstrates majority
14	community support for the request; and
15	(4) agrees to file quarterly reports to the Department of Education and Early

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1 Development of the effects on student and teacher performance of the four-day school week.

- 2 (b) The board may approve a four-day school week under this section for not more 3 than one school district, based on the best interests of affected students and the timing of a 4 request received by the board that meets the requirements in (a) of this section.
- 5 (c) On or before January 15 of each year in which a four-day school week is in effect 6 in a school district, the board shall file a report with the legislative committees whose primary 7 responsibility is education on the progress and performance ratings of a school district 8 approved for a four-day school week under this section. The report must include a comparison 9 of the performance ratings of the school district before and after the implementation of the 10 four-day school week.

11 (d) In this section,

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- (1) "board" means the state Board of Education and Early Development;
- (2) "school district" has the meaning given to "district" in AS 14.17.990.
