

- Measurement standards/commercial vehicle enforcement





## DOT&PF Regional Boundaries






# FY2015 Operating Budget













#### Department of Transportation & Public Facilities Continued Budget Growth Compared to 10-Year Plan (All Funds)


#### Department of Transportation & Public Facilities Continued Budget Growth Compared to 10-Year Plan (GF Only)


#### Challenges

- Anti-icing chemicals reducing need for sand
- Herbicides save \$'s spent on brush cutting
- Hard aggregate increasing pavement life
- Eliminate low use equipment
- Simplifying processes
- Automating engineering processes


