A BILL
FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to transportation of commercial motor vehicles."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

*** Section 1.** AS 19.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 19.10.345. Transportation of commercial motor vehicles by a motor vehicle dealer. (a) When transporting a commercial motor vehicle, other than a vehicle designed to transport more than 15 passengers including the driver, that has a gross vehicle weight rating of up to 19,501 pounds from the point of assembly of the vehicle in this state to a dealership in this state, the motor vehicle dealer shall ensure that the commercial motor vehicle has dealer registration plates under AS 28.10.181(j), proof of registration, and proof of insurance as required in AS 19.10.300. The commercial motor vehicle does not have to be inspected before transport to the dealership, and the motor vehicle dealer does not have to maintain a record of inspection. The commercial motor vehicle must have all required safety equipment; however, the fire extinguishers do not have to be mounted on the

1 commercial motor vehicle.

2 (b) A driver transporting a commercial motor vehicle for a motor vehicle
3 dealer under (a) of this section must be 18 years of age or older but is not, for purposes
4 of transporting that vehicle, required to

5 (1) hold a commercial driver's license;

6 (2) complete the physical examination required under AS 28.33.100(a)
7 for issuance of a commercial driver's license; or

8 (3) maintain a driver's record of duty status logbook.

9 (c) In this section,

10 (1) "dealership" means the business entity owned by the motor vehicle
11 dealer;

12 (2) "motor vehicle dealer" has the meaning given in AS 08.66.350.
