Analysis/Assumptions: This bill names the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Conservation, or their designee, as a member of the Board of Agriculture, Conservation, and Development. The bill would expand the powers of the Board of Agriculture and Conservation to include advising the Commissioners of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Fish and Game (F&G), and Environmental Conservation (DEC) on the promotion, regulation, and protection of the agricultural and food industry to broaden economic base of the state and to protect consumers.
