- Sec. 28.01.017. Municipal regulation of cellular telephone use.

 Notwithstanding other provisions of this title, a municipality may adopt an ordinance prohibiting the use of a cellular telephone by a person operating a motor vehicle while on school property or in a school zone designated under the current edition of the Alaska Traffic Manual prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public
