HB 167 Sectional Analysis

Section 1. Amends AS 08.48.221 by requiring registrants to sign the seal on documents. Deletes language that allows the registrant to certify on the face of the document the extent of the registrant's responsibility.

Section 2. Adds a new subsection to AS 08.48.221 that requires documents containing the work of multiple fields of practice to be sealed and signed by a registrant in each of the fields covered by the document.

Section 3. Changes the exemption for buildings for residence by not more than four families to not more than three families. Adds "architect, land surveying, or landscape architecture" to this section wherever "engineering" appears. Adds language to the exceptions regarding revegetation or placement of plant material to require a board determination that the action does not affect the public health, safety, or welfare.

Section 4. Adds definitions for "design of minor importance," "shop drawing" and "field drawing."
