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## **Analysis**

This legislation affirms the current practice, by adding new subsection to AS 39.28.040, of employing individuals with a disability in an integrated workplace where individuals with disabilities work with and alongside of individuals without disabilities and are paid a comparable wage to those individuals who do not have a disability but are doing the same or similar work.
