## **HB214 Sectional Analysis**

**Section 1.** Adds a new paragraph to AS 44.65.030(a) AS 47.30.847(a)(3) (mental health patient grievance appeals).

<u>Section2</u>. Adds three additional rights to the eleven existing rights of a person undergoing mental health evaluation or treatment in the state under specified provisions of state law, including involuntary commitments. The additional rights include; the basic right to file a grievance, the right to have an advocate, and the right to maintain a natural support system that would include family, friends, and help networks.

**Section 3.** Repeals the existing statute under AS 47.30.847 and reenacts it. Establishes standardized grievance procedures within the state. Defines "grievance", "grievant", and "unit".

<u>Section 4.</u> Amends AS47.30.855 adding two new subsections for posting standardized notices of grievance procedures under AS 47.30.847.
