- DM \$37.5

Alaska Sovereign Education Fund

- Alaska's Land-Grant University Equivalency
- Fraction of State Earning in Oil/Gas/Mining
 - Legislative-controlled account
 - Appropriated annually only to:
 - University Building Fund (UBF)
 - System-wide capital, capital maintenance, equipment
 - Initial Seed Money for UBF
 - Applied to UBF upon being signed into law
- Apportionment Limits (Annual)
 - Higher education receives first \$50M
 - Legislature determines appropriation or savings of excess
- Long Term Goal
 - Modernize university technology, equipment
 - Materially reduce facilities falling into DM status
