FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to golf course alcoholic beverage licenses."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 *** Section 1.** AS 04.11.115(a) is amended to read:

4 (a) A golf course license authorizes the licensee to sell or serve alcoholic
5 beverages [BEER AND WINE] on licensed premises located on a golf course from
6 April 15 through November 15 of a calendar year.

7 *** Sec. 2.** AS 04.11.115(d) is amended to read:

8 (d) Food similar to that listed in the sample menu must be available during
9 times when alcoholic beverages [BEER AND WINE] are sold, served, and consumed
10 on the licensed premises.

11 *** Sec. 3.** AS 04.16.049(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) A person under the age of 21 years may not knowingly enter or remain in
13 premises licensed under this title unless

14 (1) accompanied by a parent, guardian, or spouse who has attained the
15 age of 21 years;

1 (2) the person is at least 16 years of age, the premises are designated
2 by the board as a restaurant for the purposes of this section, and the person enters and
3 remains only for dining; [OR]

4 (3) the person is under the age of 16 years, is accompanied by a person
5 over the age of 21 years, the parent or guardian of the underage [UNDERAGED]
6 person consents, the premises are designated by the board as a restaurant for the
7 purposes of this section, and the person enters and remains only for dining; or

8 (4) the premises are licensed under AS 04.11.115 and the person
9 enters and remains on the licensed premises

10 (A) only for golfing; or

11 (B) only for dining, or for both golfing and dining, if

12 (i) the person is at least 16 years of age; or

13 (ii) the person is under 16 years of age, is
14 accompanied by a person over 21 years of age, and the parent or
15 guardian of the underage person consents.

16 * Sec. 4. AS 04.16.060(e) is amended to read:

17 (e) A person under the age of 21 who is seeking to enter and remain in a
18 licensed premises under AS 04.16.049(a)(2) - (4) [AS 04.16.049(a)(2) OR (3)] may
19 not misrepresent the person's age or having obtained the consent of the parent or
20 guardian required by that section.

21 * Sec. 5. AS 04.11.115(b)(2) is repealed.
