Analysis

SB189 allows an owner builder to act as their own contractor without securing a license under AS 08.18 if the structure is not advertised for sale or sold within two years of completion, and if advertised or sold the owner can demonstrate to the department's satisfaction that the sale would not result in circumvention of this chapter.		
The division does not anticipate a need for increased authority as a result of this legislation, although there may be an increase in enforcement action and investigative costs.
