9	A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING REPEAL OF AS 39.35.625, A STATUTE REQUIRING
10	TERMINATION STUDIES, AND A PROVISION FOR A SUSTAINABLE SALARY
11	BASE TO PAY OFF PERS UNFUNDED OBLIGATIONS
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13	WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has helped Alaska's municipalities
14	tremendously in adopting a rate of 22% of salary to help fund the current costs and the
15	unfunded liability of the PERS/TRS system; and
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17	WHEREAS, Alaska Legislators have worked hard to develop a fair and equitable
18	solution to an existing problem and never intended to create inequitable financial
19	damage to any PERS member employer or negatively interfere with the current or future
20	delivery of any member's services or programs; and
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22	WHEREAS, application of AS 39.35.625 requires an employer that terminates
23	participation of a department, group or other classification of employees in the plan, to
24	undergo a termination study that may result in incurring: 1)the cost of the termination
25	study; 2)costs determined by the study to be owed to PERS due to the change; and

3)past service cost as determined by the study. These three cost increments may run
to many hundreds of thousands of dollars or more; and

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WHEREAS, termination studies nullify the intent of legislation to establish a single uniform statutory contribution rate for PERS employers, as they will be required to pay the PERS termination costs in addition to the amounts required under the single uniform contribution rate; and

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WHEREAS, municipalities, in the future, may find themselves paying more toward the unfunded obligation every pay period for positions that no longer exist, than for existing and/or current positions; and

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WHEREAS, AS 39.35.625 creates an inequitable impact on small PERS employers
 versus larger PERS employers; and

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WHEREAS, concerns that employers would purposely act in a manner that jeopardizes
payment of the unfunded obligation, and thus shrink the salary base that pays off the
unfunded obligation, has not occurred.

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NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Municipal League, while supporting a sustainable salary base to pay off the PERS unfunded obligation, believes that AS 39.35.625 and any other similar statutes or regulations that require termination studies, should be repealed.

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50	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Alaska Municipal League urges the Legislature
51	to amend AS 39.35.255(a)(2), with inflation adjustment language, to provide a more
52	efficient, cost-effective and equitable method of ensuring that the required PERS salary
53	base is maintained.
