<p>ALASKA RESIDENT AS 16.05.415 AND AS 16.05.940: "resident" means a person (including an alien) who is physically present in Alaska with the intent to remain indefinitely and make a home here, has maintained that person's domicile in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding this application for a license, and is not claiming residency or obtaining benefits under a claim of residency in another state, territory, or country; a member of the military service or U.S. Coast Guard who has been stationed in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding this application for a license; or a dependent of a resident member of the military service or U.S. Coast Guard who has lived in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding this application for a license. A person who does not otherwise qualify as a resident may not qualify by virtue of an interest in an Alaska business. A person who establishes residency as outlined above remains a resident during an absence from the state unless during the absence the person (1) establishes or gains residency in another state, territory or country; or (2) performs an act or is absent under circumstances that are inconsistent with the intent to remain indefinitely and make a home in Alaska. If you are not in substantial compliance with a child support order, are on Child Support Services Division's (CSSD) outstanding report, your license is null and void at the time of purchase. You will be subject to criminal sanctions for participation in any commercial crewmember activities. 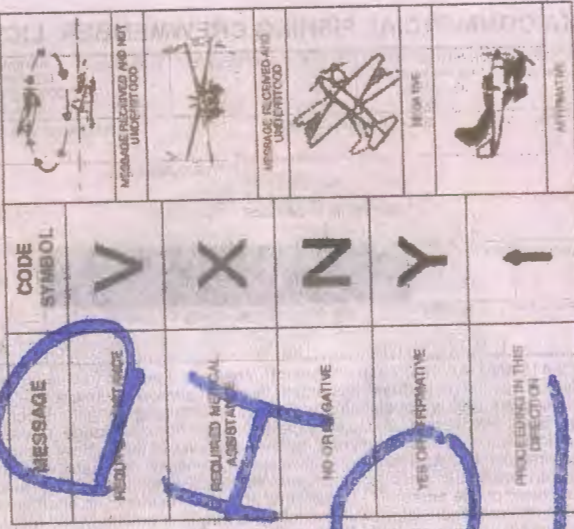

GROUND TO AIR SIGNALS

Make signals not less than eight feet. Provide maximum contrast - red, white, black, orange and is the best light.



Social Security Number Advisory: You are required to provide your U.S. social security number when applying for a Commercial Crewmember License. Even if you are not a U.S. Citizen you will be denied a license if you do not give your social security number.

Holders of a commercial fishing crewmember license could be eligible for Fishermen's Fund medical benefits if you are injured or become ill due to commercial fishing activities in Alaska. Persons who are exempt from obtaining a crew member license include the permit holder, processing workers on floating fish processing vessels who do not operate fishing gear or engage in activities related to navigation or operation of the vessel, and guests or visitors who do not directly or indirectly participate in the taking or transporting of fish. An entry or interim-use permit from any fishery can be used as a crewmember license.
