Analysis

This bill amends AS14.17.470 Base student allocation (BSA) with an increase of \$404 from \$5,680 to \$6,084 for FY2015.
In the subsequent fiscal years, following FY2015, the BSA will be increased using the inflation adjustment based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI-U) for all urban consumers in the Anchorage metropolitan area with a base index of the first half of 2013.
The projected CPI-U used to calculate FY2016 and out years is 2.5%.
The effective date is July 1, 2014.
