## A BILL <br> FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to residential educational programs; increasing the stipend for boarding school students; and providing for an effective date."

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 14.16 is amended by adding a new section to article 2 to read:

Sec. 14.16.100. Application for residential school. A school district shall apply to the department for approval to establish and operate a statewide or districtwide residential school. The department shall accept applications during an open application period conducted annually. A period of open application in itself does not indicate that the department will approve the establishment of a new residential school.

* Sec. 2. AS 14.16.200(b) is amended to read:
(b) Costs that may be claimed by a district for reimbursement under (a) of this section are
(I) one round trip on the least expensive means of transportation
between the student's community of residence and the school during the school year if the district expends money for the trip; and
(2) a per-pupil monthly stipend to cover room and board expenses as determined by the department on a regional basis and not to exceed the following amounts:

> (A) for the Southeast Region (Region I), $\$ 1,230[\$ 820]$; (B) for the Southcentral Region (Region II), $\underline{\$ 1,200}[\$ 800]$; (C) for the Interior Region (Region III), $\$ 1,452[\$ 968] ;$ (D) for the Southwest Region (Region IV), $\$ 1,509[\$ 1,006]$; (E) for the Northern Remote Region (Region V), $\$ 1,776$

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 2014.
