3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- * **Section 1.** AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to article 3 to read:
- Sec. 08.64.364. Prescription of drugs without physical examination. (a) The board may not impose disciplinary sanctions on a physician for prescribing, dispensing, or administering a prescription drug to a person without conducting a
- 8 physical examination if
- 9 (1) the prescription drug is not a controlled substance;
- 10 (2) the physician is located in this state and available to provide 11 follow-up care; and
- 12 (3) the person consents to sending a copy of all records of the 13 encounter to the person's primary care provider if the prescribing physician is not the 14 person's primary care provider, and the physician sends the records to the person's
