FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- *** Section 1.** AS 14.33.220(b) is amended to read:
- 5 (b) A school employee, student, or volunteer who has witnessed, or has
- 6 reliable information that a student has been subjected to, harassment, intimidation, or
- bullying [, WHETHER VERBAL OR PHYSICAL,] shall report the incident to an
- 8 appropriate school official.
- 9 * **Sec. 2.** AS 14.33.250(2) is amended to read:
- 10 (2) "harassment, intimidation, or bullying" means an intentional
- written, <u>electronic</u>, or oral <u>communication</u>, or physical act, when the
- communication or act is undertaken with the intent of threatening, intimidating,
- harassing, or frightening the student, and
- 14 (A) physically harms the student or damages the student's
