BILL NO. HB 373

Analysis

This bill will create a new 24/7 program that will be run by the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS). People who participate in the program may qualify to receive a limited license issued by DMV or the Court. Upon notification from DHSS, the DMV will be required to cancel the limited license of participants who fail to comply with the requirements of the 24/7 program. The person will then be required to use the traditional limited license and an ignition interlock device (IID).

Expenditures:

The DMV database will need to have additional programming to create a field for expiration dates for limited licenses related to the 24/7 program.

Estimated programming hours: 40

Cost per hour: \$143

Total programming cost: 40 x \$143 = \$5,720

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
