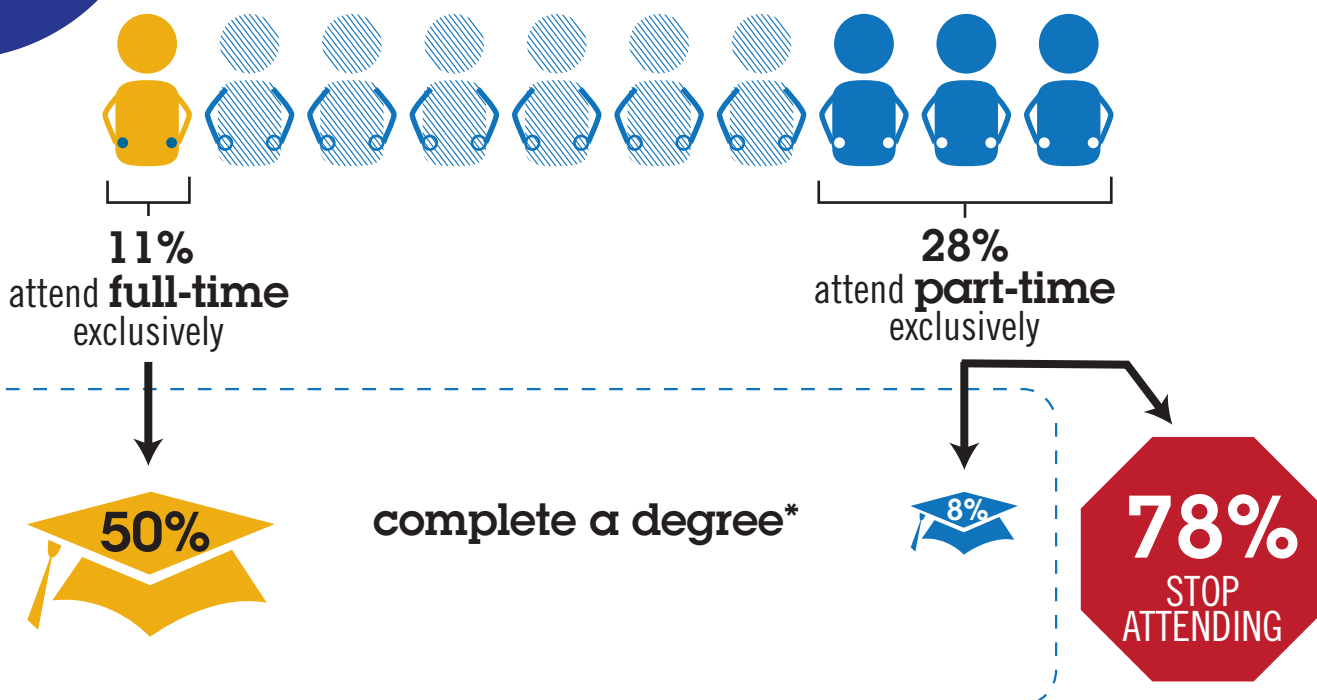

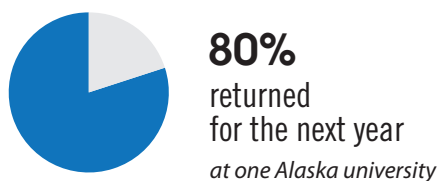

What is gained with on-time attendance?

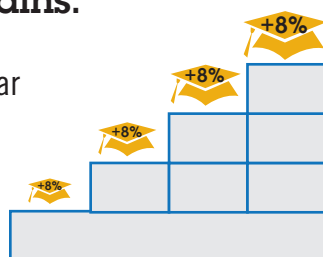
4-year track

15+ credits per semester

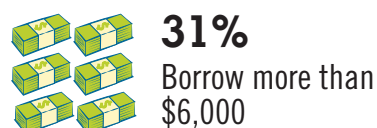
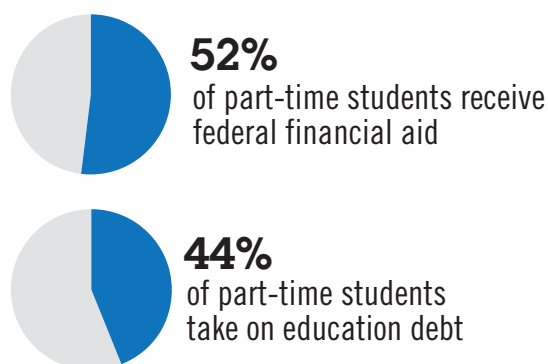


Cumulative gains:
