#### A BILL

### FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to exemptions from the payment of motor vehicle registration fees for residents 65 years of age or older; and providing for an effective date."

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

- \* Section 1. AS 28.10.411(f) is amended to read:
  - (f) A resident 65 years of age or older on the date the registration fee is due [ON JANUARY 1 OF THE YEAR THE VEHICLE IS REGISTERED] or a resident with a disability that limits or impairs the ability to walk and who provides proof of that disability as provided in 23 C.F.R. 1235.2 is entitled to an exemption from the registration fee required under this section for one vehicle subject to registration under AS 28.10.421(b)(1), (2), (5), or (6). An exemption may not be granted except upon written application for the exemption on a form prescribed by the department.
- \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2015.
