FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. CSHCR15(L&C)

Analysis

HCR 15 creates the continuation of a task force on unmanned aircraft systems within the legislative branch. The task force will have 12 members which will be comprised of the 7 members from the HCR 6 original task force and 5 new members. The task force intends to meet as needed during and between sessions. They anticipate having a meeting during the summer, one during the fall and one right before the 2015 session. Because of the residence of the task force members and location of the meetings, a minimalist travel budget is incorporated into this fiscal note. Teleconference and printing costs will be absorbed within existing budgets and they intend to utilize existing staff.
