FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

- "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration plates; and providing for an effectivedate."
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:
- * **Section 1.** AS 28.10.161(b) is amended to read:
- 5 (b) Every passenger vehicle registration plate, except as specifically provided
- 6 in AS 28.10.181, shall have displayed upon it
- 7 (1) <u>either</u>
- 8 (A) the Alaska flag design, consisting of the Alaska flag, [;
- 9 (2)] the traditional colors of yellow-gold and blue, and [; (3)] the slogan "The
- 10 Last Frontier"; or
- 11 (B) the bear design, consisting of a standing grizzly bear in
- the center of the plate; the bear design shall be modeled after the 1976
- bicentennial plate without the bicentennial symbol;
- 14 (2) [(4)] the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which it is

1	issued;
2	(3) [(5)] the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and
3	(4) [(6)] the registration year number or expiration date for which time
4	it is validated; the registration year number or expiration date may be part of the
5	license plate or contained on a suitable sticker or tab device issued by the department;
6	however, only one sticker or tab device may be issued for each pair of plates, and the
7	sticker or tab device must be affixed to the rear plate.
8	* Sec. 2. AS 28.10.161 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	(d) The department shall produce registration plates in both of the designs
10	described in (b)(1) of this section. Upon registering a passenger vehicle, the owner
11	shall select the plate design described in (b)(1) of this section that is to be issued by
12	the department for the vehicle.
