### Summary of Changes in HB 270 Version U to Version N

The changes made in the *Blank CS for HB270 28-LS1270\N* are as follows:

**On page 1, line 7:** deletes “and” and inserts “or.” This corrects an error in existing statute applying rules to citations issued by both a peace officer and another person authorized to issue citations. The rules should apply to citations issued by either.

**On page 2, lines 7-9:** inserts: “the offense is punishable by a fine of \$500 or less.” This limits the citations that can be served by leaving them on property or by civil processes to offenses with a maximum fine less than \$500. This matches the threshold for most violations under state law (AS 12.55.035(b)(7)), though it is half the maximum permitted for municipal violations (AS 29.25.070(a)).

**On page 2, line 10:** inserts “in a conspicuous place.” This requires citations left on real or personal property to be visible and obvious on that property.
