FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA 2014 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

BILL NO. SB185

Analysis

Section 6 of this legislation amends AS 14.17.470 by adding a new subsection that would provide charter schools with a separate base student allocation (BSA) dollar amount that would be 10% higher than the BSA used in the foundation program. This would increase the charter school BSA from \$5,680 to \$6,248, which is a \$568 BSA increase.

The fiscal impact is calculated by applying the proposed 10% higher charter school BSA to the FY2015 projected charter school adjusted ADM. The state cost would be \$5,037,699.

This charter school BSA, the 10% increase, would become part of the formula and the higher level of funding would become part of the base foundation program cost and be provided each year as part of the ongoing calculation. As the bill is currently written, it is unclear if the 10% charter school BSA increase is on an annual basis, therefore EED calculated it into the formula in the FY2015 budget only.

If a second BSA is assigned to any adjusted ADM (charter schools in this case), the methodology by which the foundation formula maintains weighted per pupil funding may be compromised and the State of Alaska would be at risk of not qualifying for the use of federal impact aid dollars as a portion the foundation formula costs. Currently Alaska passes the annual impact aid program disparity test and the state is allowed to use approximately \$70 million dollars in federal impact aid funds towards the foundation program costs. If the state fails to maintain a weighted average disparity in compliance with the impact aid program, the state would need to supplement with the \$70 million dollars in general funds to maintain current level funding. Based on actual annual foundation and disparity calculations, any impacts on the dollars per weighted average are a significant concern. Without further information, a fiscal impact for failing the disparity test is not included in the cost of this fiscal note.

The appropriation and out year costs for this legislation are reported in a separate fiscal note for the Public Education Fund (PEF).
