## **Analysis**

CSHB 167 amends statutes for architects, engineers, land surveyors, and landscape architects to increase accountability of licensee work and to ensure only licensed professionals are performing work within the scope of this chapter. The CS differs from HB 167 by keeping original statutory language in AS 08.48.331(a)(6)(C)(i) as is. This bill adds or amends language to exiting architects, engineers, and surveyor statutes to clarify the manner and conditions for sealing and signing drawings, specifications, surveys, plats, plates, reports, or similar documents.
