A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to the authority of the victims' advocate to request a hearing for the

2 release to a crime victim under certain conditions of certain property in the custody of a

3 law enforcement agency."

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

5 * Section 1. AS 12.36.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 (f) If the agency fails to act on a request under (a) of this section within the 7 deadline set in (b) of this section, the victims' advocate may request a hearing under 8 (b) of this section. If the victims' advocate requests a hearing under this subsection, the 9 role of the victims' advocate in the hearing is limited to advocating for the return of the 10 victim's property; the victims' advocate may not participate in the case as a party or an 11 intervenor unless the court orders otherwise.

12 *** Sec. 2.** AS 24.65.115 is amended to read:

13Sec. 24.65.115. Authority to request return of property on behalf of14certain persons. (a) Notwithstanding another provision of this chapter, the victims'

(1) file a request under AS 12.36.070 with a law enforcement agency
for the return of property to a crime victim after having conducted an investigation and
determining that the crime victim is entitled to the return of the property under the
factors listed in AS 12.36.070(c);

(2) request a hearing under AS 12.36.070(f).

7 (b) In fulfilling the requirements of this section, the victims' advocate may use
8 any of the powers granted to the advocate under this chapter.
