**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

**"An Act relating to the state and municipal procurement preferences for agricultural products harvested in the state and fisheries products harvested or processed in the state; and providing for an effective date."**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

**\* Section 1.** AS 29.71.040(a) is amended to read:

(a) When agricultural products are purchased by a municipality that receives state money, only agricultural products harvested in the state shall be purchased whenever priced not [NO] more than 12 [SEVEN] percent above products harvested outside the state, available, and of like quality compared with agricultural products harvested outside the state.

**\* Sec. 2.** AS 29.71.040(b) is amended to read:

(b) When fisheries products are purchased by a municipality that receives state money, only fisheries products harvested or processed within the jurisdiction of the state shall be purchased whenever priced not [NO] more than 12 [SEVEN] percent

1 above products harvested or processed outside the jurisdiction of the state, available,  
2 and of like quality compared with fisheries products harvested or processed outside  
3 the jurisdiction of the state.

5 (a) When agricultural products are purchased by the state or by a school  
6 district that receives state money, a 12 [SEVEN] percent preference shall be applied to  
7 the price of the products harvested in the state.

9 (b) When fisheries products are purchased by the state or by a school district  
10 that receives state money, a 12 [SEVEN] percent preference shall be applied to the  
11 price of the products harvested or processed within the jurisdiction of the state.
