In July 2013, after receipt of \$600,000 for the first year of the proposed three-year project, <u>Partners for Progress, the Alaska Native Justice Center (ANJC), and Nine Star Education and</u> Employment Services worked together to open Partners Reentry Center (Center) in August.

We operate <u>in collaboration with the Department of Corrections (DOC)</u>, receiving many participants directly after they released from prison. Most of the others are on referral from half-way houses under contract with DOC. There are also some walk-ins.
