# **Analysis**

This legislation would ban smoking in enclosed areas at all 252 State of Alaska rural airports including state-owned airport terminals, fuel facilities and other enclosed areas in a place of employment (sand storage sheds, equipment storage/maintenance facilities, airport rescue/firefighting facilities). The department would provide durable signs at these locations.
