A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act relating to prescription of drugs by a physician without a physical

2 examination."

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

4 * Section 1. AS 08.64 is amended by adding a new section to article 3 to read:

5 Sec. 08.64.364. Prescription of drugs without physical examination. (a) The 6 board may not impose disciplinary sanctions on a physician for prescribing, 7 dispensing, or administering a prescription drug to a person without conducting a 8 physical examination if

9 (1) the prescription drug is

10 (A) not a controlled substance; or
11 (B) a controlled substance and is prescribed, dispensed, or
12 administered by a physician when an appropriate licensed health care provider
13 is present with the patient to assist the physician with examination, diagnosis,
14 and treatment;

1 (2) the physician is located in this state and the physician or another 2 physician in the physician's group practice is available to provide follow-up care; and 3 the person consents to sending a copy of all records of the (3) 4 encounter to the person's primary care provider if the prescribing physician is not the 5 person's primary care provider, and the physician sends the records to the person's 6 primary care provider. 7 (b) In this section, 8 (1) "controlled substance" has the meaning given in AS 11.71.900; 9 (2) "prescription drug" has the meaning given in AS 08.80.480; 10 (3) "primary care provider" has the meaning given in AS 21.07.250.
